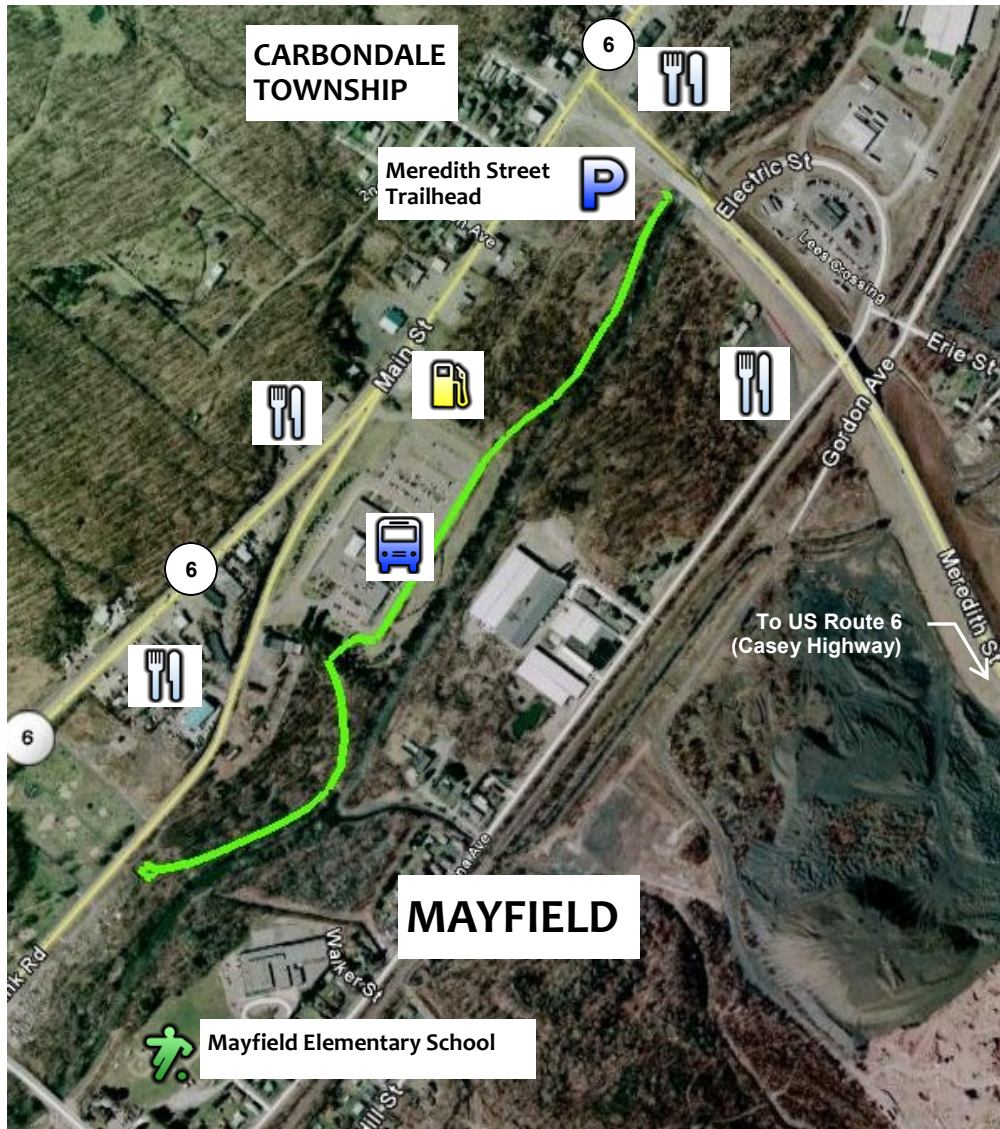

The **New York Ontario and Western (NY O&W) Railroad Trail** is a section of the Lackawanna River Heritage Trail that travels from Carbondale Township to Mayfield. Slightly less than a mile long (0.7 mile), it offers a scenic and open walk along the Lackawanna River. The NY O&W section is finished with a crushed stone surface to allow a low impact surface for walking, running, and biking.

The trail section begins at the trailhead parking lot on Meredith Street in Carbondale Township and it

travels south through the property of St. Rose Academy in Mayfield. Approximately half way along the trail, stop and enjoy a look-out point by the river that allows you to feel like you are on top of the rushing water below. The trail ends at a cul-de-sac with a gentle loop. However, trail users have the option of using a short access trail to connect to Old Plank Road and continue their journey.
