The Heritage Explorer Bike Tour is a multi component event. It will take a lot of volunteers to help make this inaugural Bike Tour a successful community event. Volunteers are needed under two different positions. Please select the one that fits your interests.

The Heritage Crew Responsibilities

The Heritage Crew volunteers will help with registration, set up and tear down, serve snacks and beverages at rest areas, assist riders at turn-around points, or may choose to spend their time at Mellow Park helping with tour activities.

Responsibilities

- **Start Area:** Set up and tear down tables, assist riders, provide breakfast and help with registration.
- **Route Turnarounds:** There are four turn-around points that will have comfort facilities, a water station, and a Heritage Fun Stop. Volunteers greet and assist riders, help to set up and tear down, distribute snacks and water, direct traffic flow, and clean up the trail after the Bike Tour is completed. All turn-around areas are accessible by car, and parking is available.
- **Tour Finish:** Hand out swag bags and certificates. Clean up the trail, Mellow Park, and tear down the registration and start area.
- **Friday Kick-Off Party:** Help with raffles, set up and tear down tables, and assist with serving.

The Explorer Guides

The Explorer Guide volunteers are experienced cyclists who will provide assistance along the route, and who will help to keep the Bike Tour on schedule. Good bike repair and people skills are helpful. Explorer Guides must be 16 years or older. On the day of the Bike Tour, Explorer Guides will report to Mellow Park. They will be directed to their posts along the bike route and will provide assistance wherever needed.

Responsibilities

- Provide assistance at the registration area.
- Direct riders as the Bike Tour passes their post.
- Alert participants to specific traffic and road conditions.
- Assist with bike repair and road emergencies.
- Encourage slow riders.
- Provide information the SAG wagon or emergency vehicles.
