TRAILHEADS / PARKING:

Meredith Street Trailhead
 Located off Exit 6 - Meredith Street from US Route 6 (Casey Highway).

The **New York Ontario and Western Rail Trail** (NY O&W) offers a scenic and open walk along the Lackawanna River in Mayfield. The NY O&W section of the Lackawanna River Heritage Trail is complete and open to the public. The Trail is finished with a crushed stone surface to allow a low impact surface for walking, jogging, and mountain biking.

This section begins on Meredith Street in Carbondale Township and travels South, through the property of St. Rose Academy, Mayfield. Approximately half way through the

trail, stop and enjoy a look-out point that allows you to feel like you are on top of the rushing water below.

The NY O&W Trail allows for a relaxing stroll along the Lackawanna River, with benches to relax and enjoy the natural beauty of your surroundings.
